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## Multiple Myeloma Research Foundation 2013 - Research Fellow Award.

<b>Description</b>	The <b>Multiple Myeloma Research Foundation (MMRF)</b> seeks proposals for the <b>MMRF 2013 Research Fellow Award Program</b> , an initiative supporting researchers at the post doctorate/medical fellow or junior faculty levels working under the supervision or guidance of a research mentor in the <b>multiple myeloma field</b> .
<b>Amount</b>	Proposals may request <b>up to \$75,000 total costs</b> , including up to 10% indirect costs, for a <b>one (1) year period</b> .
<b>Eligibility</b>	<p>Applications for the MMRF 2013 Research Fellow Award Program are solicited from <b>investigators at academic, not-for-profit, institutions</b>.</p> <p>You must be a <b>researcher who holds a Ph.D., M.D. or equivalent degree and has less than 5 years of experience from the highest degree obtained</b>.</p> <p><b>Post-doctorate and medical fellows</b> applying for the award <b>must work under the supervision of a research mentor in the multiple myeloma field</b>.</p> <p><b>Investigators at the level of assistant professor</b> who are <b>beginning studies in the multiple myeloma field</b> and are thereby applying for this award <b>must have a research sponsor at their institution who is in the multiple myeloma field</b> and can provide guidance to the applicant in the area of the project proposed.</p>

## Associazione Italiana Celiachia - Call for Proposals 2013.

<b>Description</b>	<p>The <b>Fondazione Celiachia (FC)</b> is inviting Applications to grant <b>three-years Italian research projects in the area of celiac disease and gluten associated pathologies.</b></p> <p>These grants are intended to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. support the research of established and independent scientists, leading an existing research unit</li> <li>2. encourage talented young researchers to submit their research proposals.</li> </ol> <p><b>The scientific activity must be carried out in a non-profit research institution located in Italy (university, hospital or other research center).</b></p>
<b>Amount</b>	<p>Grants are for a <b>three-year period</b>, contingent upon the presentation of yearly renewal requests. Funding applications <b>must not exceed € 100,000 per year.</b></p> <p><b>Applications exceeding € 100,000 per year will not be taken into consideration.</b></p>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>→ <b>Applicants can be of any nationality.</b> They should have achieved scientific independence, and they <b>must have a good track record</b>, as demonstrated by primary research papers (no reviews) in high level peer-reviewed journals.</li> <li>→ <b>Applicants must operate in a non-profit Italian Institution</b> for the entire duration of the grant.</li> <li>→ Proposals must <b>have a clear focus on celiac disease and gluten associated pathologies and proposed research plans should fall into one of the following Research Areas:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. ## AACR Outstanding Investigator Award for Breast Cancer Research, funded by Susan G. Komen for the Cure®.

<b>Description</b>	The <b>AACR Outstanding Investigator Award for Breast Cancer Research</b> , funded by Susan G. Komen for the Cure®, will recognize an <b>investigator whose novel and significant work</b> has had or may have a <b>far-reaching impact on the etiology, detection, diagnosis, treatment, or prevention of breast cancer</b> . Such work may involve any discipline across the continuum of <b>biomedical research</b> , including <b>basic, translational, clinical, and epidemiological studies</b> .
<b>Amount</b>	The recipient of the award will receive a <b>\$10,000 honorarium and present a 25-minute lecture</b> at the <a href="#">36th Annual San Antonio Breast Cancer Symposium</a> . The symposium will be held December 10-14, 2013, at the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center in San Antonio, TX.
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>→ <b>All cancer researchers</b> who are <b>affiliated with any institution involved in cancer research, cancer medicine, or cancer-related biomedical science</b> anywhere in the world may be nominated. Such institutions include those in academia, industry, or government.</li> <li>→ Candidates <b>must be no more than 50 years of age</b> at the time the Award is received, i.e. born on or after December 10, 1963.</li> <li>→ The Award will be presented to an <b>individual investigator</b>. Institutions or organizations are not eligible for the Award</li> </ul>
